FUND DESCRIPTION AND SUMMARY OF INVESTMENT MANDATE

The Fund is managed with an absolute return orientation, and is structured to generate a return of 4% above inflation at a low level of risk. It is broadly diversified across asset classes including, equities, listed property, conventional bonds and inflationlinked bonds. The Fund employs active asset allocation and derivative hedging to manage and reduce downside risk

INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The Mergence CPI + 4% Prime Fund is a collective investment scheme that aims to provide investors with capital growth over the long term. The Fund is managed with the objective of producing a real return of CPI plus 4% per annum over the longer term while preserving capital over rolling 12-month periods. It may underperform relative to overall equity markets due to its focus on capital preservation and long-term capital growth.






